

Our Vision statement:

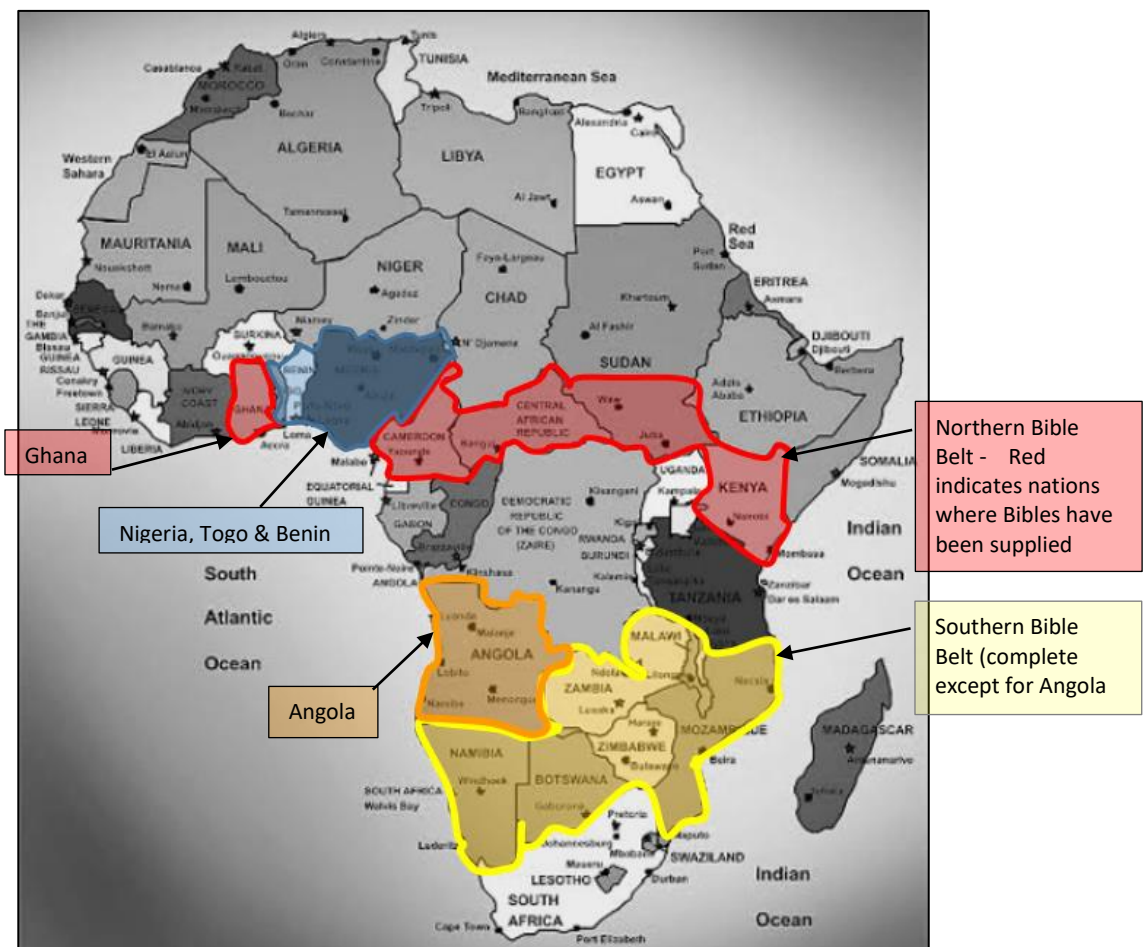
“Every member of the African Security Forces honoured before God’s throne”

Dear Supporters,

Thank you for your faithful support in these difficult times. January’s newsletter at the beginning of this year conveyed that 18,000 bibles had been ordered for the Ghana military. Those Bibles are now somewhere on a ship on their way in a 20ft container, with the Bibles weighing 18 tonnes. It is quite remarkable when you think that through your support over many years there are approximately 300 tonnes of Bibles that have been delivered into the hands of the members of the African Security Forces.

We currently have the funding to purchase 10,000 – 12,000 Bibles also for Ghana, until approximately 80,000 are in that nation. Negotiations are currently underway with the Ghanaian Bible Society with respect to the best price that is achievable and to what extent they will contribute to the totality of the order. It is desirable to have 80,000 Bibles total provided into Ghana.

Once again I put in the map to show the Northern Bible Belt.

As I mentioned in the last Newsletter, there are requests for 20,000 – 50,000 Bibles for Angola, but we just do not have the funding to consider that project at this stage. I would ask that you pray for increased support for Operation Africa.
